AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to low-point beer; amending Section 58, Chapter 274, O.S.L. 1995, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 188, O.S.L. 1996 (37 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 219.1), which relates to hours during which sales of low-point beer prohibited; modifying hours of prohibition; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 58, Chapter 274, O.S.L. 1995, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 188, O.S.L. 1996 (37 O.S. Supp. 1997, Section 219.1), is amended to read as follows:

Section 219.1 The sale of low-point beer, as defined in Section 163.2 of this title, for off-premises consumption is hereby prohibited between the hours of ~~two o'clock a.m.~~ 12 midnight and ~~six o'clock~~ 6 a.m. ~~of the same day.~~ Any holder of a retail license or permit to sell low-point beer, or an employee or agent of a holder of such a license or permit, who sells low-point beer in violation of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Such violation shall be additional grounds for

revocation of any license or permit for the sale of low-point beer,
as and in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1998.
