SENATE BILL NO. 854

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads and bridges; designating the Korean Veterans War Bridge; requiring the Department of Transportation to place and maintain certain markers on certain bridge; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1628 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge on Interstate Highway 240 at Western Avenue which crosses over Western Avenue in Oklahoma City in Oklahoma County, shall be designated as the "Korean War Veterans Bridge". Such name shall serve as an expression of the appreciation of the entire State of Oklahoma and to memorialize the men and women who served in the War. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed and maintained on the bridge bearing such name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
