AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission for

Teacher Preparation; requiring budgeting in certain
categories and amounts; providing for duties and
compensation of employees; limiting the salary of
the Executive Director; providing budgetary
limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA COMMISSION FOR TEACHER PREPARATION

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the
Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation shall budget all funds
in the following categories and amounts:

Preparation and Professional Development of Teachers and Administrators	\$0.00	\$0.00

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law shall be
set by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher
Preparation. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed

Fifty-six Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$56,200.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999. The Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provision of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective September 1, 1998.
