AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney

General; requiring budgeting in certain categories
and amounts; providing for duties and compensation
of employees; providing budgetary limitations; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

ATTORNEY GENERAL

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the Office
of the Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following
categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
