AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to funding public records and information agencies; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries; stating purpose; requiring certain budgeting of all funds; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; making appropriations to the Secretary of State; stating purposes; requiring certain budgeting of all funds; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF LIBRARIES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the Department of Libraries shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:
