AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Arts Council;

requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
amounts; providing for duties and compensation of  
employees; limiting the salary of the Chief  
Administrative Officer; providing budgetary  
limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA ARTS COUNCIL

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the  
Oklahoma Arts Council shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council.  
The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed

Forty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Seven Dollars (\$48,207.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999. The Oklahoma Arts Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
