AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Physician Manpower Training

Commission; amending Section 9, Chapter 312, O.S.L.

1997, which relates to budgetary limitations;

modifying certain budgetary limitations; and

declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9, Chapter 312, O.S.L.

1997, is amended to read as follows:

Section 9. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law shall be set by the Physician Manpower Training Commission. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed Forty-six Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-five Dollars (\$46,945.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998. The Physician Manpower Training Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant

to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
