AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund;
making an appropriation to the Oklahoma Capitol
Improvement Authority; stating purpose; making
appropriation nonfiscal; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1998.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
