AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution recognizing the Jenks High School Trojans as the 1997 Class 6A State Football Champions; congratulating the coaching staff and team; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Jenks High School Trojans Class 6A football team were 1997 District and Area Champions. The Trojans won the 1997 football state championship, winning back-to-back championships in 1996 and 1997. The 1997 Trojan senior class had a football team record of 14-0 in 1997 and an overall four-year record of 37 wins and 2 losses. The Jenks High School Trojans Class 6A football team now holds the all-time play-off scoring record of 42.2 points per game as well as the all-time play-off defensive scoring record of 3.5 points per game. Many of the individual Trojan football players distinguished themselves and were honored by the media for their achievements. Coach Allan Trimble was named 1997 Coach of the Year for 6A Football.
