AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution designating certain campus as University Center at Tulsa; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the land on which the campus of Rogers University is located is owned by the University Center at Tulsa Trust Authority; and

WHEREAS, several higher education institutions currently offer and will continue to offer upper division undergraduate and graduate level courses at the campus; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain a consistent community presence, to avoid confusion, and to create a hospitable environment for higher education providers in Tulsa, it is desirable that the campus be known by an inclusive reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION OF THE 46th OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT upon and after the passage of this resolution the campus on which Rogers University is located shall be named and referenced in signage, contracts and other legal documents, and other information pieces as the University Center at Tulsa.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the University Center at Tulsa Trust Authority, Board of Regents of Rogers University, and the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
