AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution directing the State Board of Education to provide copies of a comparison of the State Aid Funding Formula allocation; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the State Board of Education received a total appropriation of One Billion Seven Hundred Twenty-two Million One Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$1,722,106,635.00) for the 1999 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, of this amount the State Board of Education is to allocate through the State Aid Funding Formula the amount of Twenty-three Million Dollars (\$23,000,000.00) for the purpose of meeting the new Minimum Teacher Salary Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 46TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT it is the desire of the Oklahoma Senate that the State Board of Education shall provide, free of charge, to the public, copies of the State Aid Funding Formula allocation, by school district, comparing the allocation of the total amount of funds appropriated by the Oklahoma Legislature for the 1999 fiscal year to an allocation which does not include Twenty-three Million Dollars (\$23,000,000.00) appropriated by the Legislature to meet the new Minimum Teacher Salary Schedule.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the State Board of Education and the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
