AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution honoring the Washington High School's 1996 Class A Football Champions; welcoming the coaches and team to the State Capitol; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Washington Warriors football team of Washington High School in McClain County District I-5 were 1991 State Quarterfinalists with an 11-2 season. The Washington Warriors were 1992 State Semifinalists with an 11-3 season and 1993 State Quarterfinalists with a 10-3 season. In 1994 the Warriors were in the State Play-offs with a 10-2 season and 1995 State Quarterfinalists with a 12-1 season; and

WHEREAS, in 1996 the Washington Warriors football team of Washington High School in McClain County District I-5 were Class A District Champions, Bi-District Champions, Regional Champions, Area Champions, and State Champions with a 14-0 season.
