AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, lines 8 through 9, restore the stricken
title to read

"An Act relating to law enforcement; amending 19 O.S. 1991, Section 553, which relates to sheriffs; amending 47 O.S. 1991, Section 2-313, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 181, O.S.L. 1996 (47 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 2-313), which relates to the Department of Public Safety; amending 63 O.S. 1991, Section 2-103, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 387, O.S.L. 1998 (63 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 2-103), which relates to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control Commission; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 150.23, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 134, O.S.L. 1997 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 150.23), which relates to custody and possession of sidearms and badges of certain law enforcement officers; expanding circumstances for awarding badges and sidearms to family and next of kin and modifying officers to which this provision is applicable; and providing an effective date."
