An Act relating to the Governmental Tort Claims Act; providing that the state and political subdivisions of the state are immune from liability for losses caused by certain failure or malfunction of computer software or computer devices; providing that no cause of action may be brought against the state, political subdivisions, officers and employees, and immune contractors for certain failure or malfunction of computer software or computer devices; requiring certain provision in contracts; providing that contracts will be construed in certain manner; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 85.7, as last amended by Section 31 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1845 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to competitive bid procedures; exempting certain purchases from competitive bidding procedures under certain circumstances; providing for termination of exemption; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 1, strike the title to read

"[ Government Tort Claims Act - immunity from liability  
- Y2K - procedures - codification -
