- Governor's Mansion - State Capitol Park - effective
date)

beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
2. That the following Conference Committee Amendment be adopted:
 - a. Restore the title to read as follows:

An Act relating to tourism; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 7, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 1992 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 7), which relates to the Governor's Mansion; authorizing certain expenses; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1811, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 157, O.S.L. 1997 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 1811), which relates to the Division of Parks; extending date for certain pilot program; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 1816, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 167, O.S.L. 1998 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 1816), which relates to unclassified positions; modifying employee positions included in the unclassified service; and providing an effective date
