An Act relating to poor persons; amending Section 3, Chapter 414, O.S.L. 1997, as amended by Section 12, Chapter 429, O.S.L. 1998 (56 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 230.52), which relates to the Statewide Temporary Assistance Responsibility System (STARS); requiring certain conditions for subsidized and unsubsidized employment for recipients; requiring approval of work activities; requiring high school or General Equivalency Degree completion; providing that failure to obtain degree or General Equivalency Degree will be grounds for termination of benefits; and providing an effective date.
