An Act relating to child health; creating the "Oklahoma Prenatal Addiction Act"; providing for short title; stating legislative findings; adding to the duties of specified state agencies; directing the implementation of program by certain date; designating lead agency; prohibiting certain entities from refusing services to certain pregnant women; prohibiting failure or refusal to take certain action; providing penalties; providing for immunity from prosecution under certain conditions; providing for reviews by multidisciplinary teams for certain purposes; providing for petition for involuntary commitment under certain circumstances; requiring persons to make reports of unborn child in danger; prohibiting action; providing for penalties; granting immunity to certain individuals; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
