An Act relating to sex offenders; amending 22 O.S. 1991, Section 991a, as last amended by Section 31, Chapter 4, 1st Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 1999 (22 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 991a), which relates to sentencing powers of the court; authorizing polygraph test of sex offenders under certain circumstances; amending 51 O.S. 1991, Section 24A.8, which relates to law enforcement records; removing restriction for making sex offender information available; amending 57 O.S. 1991, Sections 583, 584 and 585, as last amended by Sections 2, 3 and 4, Chapter 336, O.S.L. 1999 (57 O.S. Supp. 1999, Sections 583, 584 and 585), which relate to sex offender registration; specifying types of probationary terms which shall require registration as sex offender; and providing an effective date.
