10 An Act relating to appropriations; creating the
11 Common Education Support Personnel Flexible Health
12 Benefits Revolving Fund; stating source of funds;
13 stating purpose; providing for expenditures; creating
14 the Vocational and Technical Education Support
15 Personnel Flexible Health Benefits Revolving Fund;
16 stating source of funds; stating purpose; providing
17 for expenditures; directing the Oklahoma Tax
18 Commission to deposit certain revenue from certain
19 source; directing amounts of deposit; making an
20 appropriation to the State Board of Education;
21 stating purpose; making an appropriation to the
22 Oklahoma Tax Commission; stating purpose; making an
23 appropriation to the Office of the State Treasurer;
24 stating purpose; specifying conditions of
25 appropriations; providing an effective date; and
26 declaring an emergency.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

28 SECTION 1. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
29 revolving fund for the State Department of Education to be
30 designated the "Common Education Support Personnel Flexible Health
31 Benefits Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
32 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies
received by the Department pursuant to the provisions of Section 3
of this act. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are
hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
Department for the purpose of providing for the Support Personnel
Flexible Health Benefit Allowance. Expenditures from the fund shall
be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims

1 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for
2 approval and payment.

3 SECTION 2. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
4 revolving fund for the State Department of Vocational and Technical
5 Education to be designated the "Vocational and Technical Education
6 Support Personnel Flexible Health Benefits Revolving Fund". The
7 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
8 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
9 Department pursuant to the provisions of Section 3 of this act. All
10 monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated
11 and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose
12 of providing for the Support Personnel Flexible Health Benefit
13 Allowance. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
14 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
15 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

16 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2352 of
17 Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for the fiscal year beginning
18 July 1, 1999, the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall deposit the first
19 One Million Seven Hundred Seven Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-four
20 Dollars (\$1,707,634.00) from revenues received each month from the
21 tax levied pursuant to the provisions of Section 2355 of Title 68 of
22 the Oklahoma Statutes, as follows:

23 1. Ninety-five percent (95%) shall be deposited to the Common
24 Education Support Personnel Flexible Health Benefits Revolving Fund
25 created in Section 1 of this act; and

26 2. Five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Vocational and
27 Technical Education Support Personnel Flexible Health Benefits
28 Revolving Fund created in Section 2 of this act.

29 SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
30 Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
31 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
32 ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Hundred Sixty-six Thousand

1 Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$366,250.00) or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary for the support employee flexible health benefit.

3 SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tax
4 Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
5 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00)
7 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
8 resulting from the changes in law made by Section 29 of Enrolled
9 House Bill No. 1759 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma
10 Legislature.

11 SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
12 State Treasurer from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
13 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
14 ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars
15 (\$25,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
16 duties resulting from the changes in law made by Section 29 of
17 Enrolled House Bill No. 1759 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma
18 Legislature.

19 SECTION 7. The provisions of this act are dependent upon the
20 enactment of Section 29 of Enrolled House Bill No. 1759 of the 1st
21 Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature. If Enrolled House Bill
22 No. 1759 of the 1st Session of the 47th Oklahoma Legislature is not
23 enacted, the appropriations made by this act shall be null and void.

24 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

25 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
26 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
27 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
28 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
