CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to state legislative entities; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma House of Representatives; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Legislative Service Bureau; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Oklahoma State Senate; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Hundred Thirty-four Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-nine Dollars (\$434,339.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the House of Representatives by law.

LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Legislative Service Bureau from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Seventy-two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$72,400.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to

perform the duties imposed upon the Legislative Service Bureau by law.

OKLAHOMA STATE SENATE

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Senate from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Hundred Twelve Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-two Dollars (\$312,972.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Senate by law.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 1999.
