8 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 1991,
9 Section 601.1, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter
10 416, O.S.L. 1998 (10 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 601.1),
11 which relates to the Oklahoma Commission on Children
12 and Youth; modifying membership of Commission; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 1991, Section 601.1, as
16 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 416, O.S.L. 1998 (10 O.S. Supp.
17 1998, Section 601.1), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 601.1 A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma
19 Commission on Children and Youth which shall be composed of ~~eighteen~~
20 ~~(18)~~ fifteen (15) members. The membership shall include:

21 1. The Director of the Department of Human Services, the State
22 Commissioner of Health, the Commissioner of the Department of Mental
23 Health and Substance Abuse Services, the State Superintendent of
24 Public Instruction, the Administrator of the Oklahoma Health Care
25 Authority, and the Chair of the SJR 13 Oversight Committee;

26 2. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs;

27 3. ~~Six~~ Five members who shall be appointed by the Governor ~~from~~
28 ~~a list submitted by the governing board of each of the following~~
29 ~~organizations~~ as follows:

30 a. ~~the Oklahoma Association of Children's Institutions~~
31 ~~and Agencies~~ one private provider of children's
32 services,

- 1 b. ~~two statewide associations of youth services~~
2 representatives of the business community, and
3 c. ~~the Oklahoma Bar Association,~~
4 d. ~~the Oklahoma District Attorney's Association, and two~~
5 members from the public at large
6 e. ~~a statewide court-appointed Special Advocate~~
7 ~~Association;~~

8 4. ~~One member appointed by the Governor who shall represent one~~
9 ~~of the metropolitan juvenile bureaus;~~

10 5. ~~One member from the public at large, appointed by the~~
11 ~~Governor;~~

12 6. One member, from the public at large, appointed by the
13 Speaker of the House of Representatives;

14 7. 5. One member, from the public at large, appointed by the
15 President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

16 8. 6. One member elected by the Oklahoma Planning and
17 Coordinating Council for Services to Children and Youth as provided
18 by Section 601.8 of this title. The elected member shall serve a
19 two-year term and may be reelected.

20 The appointed members shall have had active experience in ~~services~~
21 ~~to~~ working with children and youth, shall serve for a term of two
22 (2) years, and may be reappointed.

23 B. The Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth shall provide
24 a monthly report on commission member attendance to the appointing
25 authorities.

26 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
