COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to public health, directing the State Board of Health to consult with the Food and Drug Administration for assistance in establishing a program for the distribution of certain prescription drugs to medically indigent persons; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The State Department of Health shall consult with the federal Food and Drug Administration for the development of policies, rules, procedures or waivers that would assist with the implementation of a program consistent with public health and safety through which unused prescription drugs, other than prescription drugs defined as controlled dangerous substances by Section 2-101 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, may be transferred from nursing homes to repositories established for the purpose of distributing the medication to Oklahoma residents who are medically indigent.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
