COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

A Resolution concurring in the declaration of
Oklahoma Family Month; and directing distribution.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

WHEREAS, families are the bedrock of our society and the first line of support for the physical, spiritual and social needs of children; and

WHEREAS, intact, healthy families benefit our state with higher levels of happiness, health, education, employment and citizenship for adults and children alike; and

WHEREAS, intact families have fewer occurrences of child abuse, drug use, school drop-outs, welfare, crime and imprisonment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the House of Representatives concurs with Governor Keating in declaring February 1999, Oklahoma Family Month.

THAT we urge all Oklahoma families to:

1. Specifically and exclusively spend one night each week together at home playing games, reading a book or just talking to each other;

2. Count the meals your family eats together, and make a concerted effort to increase that number throughout the month; and

3. Pledge to each other that each member of the family will make a special effort to treat others with increased consideration throughout the month of February.
