10 An Act relating to state boards and commissions;
11 amending Section 14, Chapter 343, O.S.L. 1995 (74
12 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 4257), which relates to
13 employment of board or commission members; allowing
14 employment of certain ex officio members; making
15 certain exception; and declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 343, O.S.L.
18 1995 (74 O.S. Supp. 1998, Section 4257), is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 Section 4257. A. Except as otherwise provided for by this
21 section, no state board or commission shall employ any former member
22 of the board or commission.

23 B. A state board or commission may employ a former member of
24 the board or commission if at least one (1) year has passed since
25 the term of office of the former member has expired.

26 C. Notwithstanding subsection B of this section, a state board
27 or commission may employ a state employee who is an ex officio
28 member of that board or commission and who is required by law to be
29 a member of that board or commission. This subsection shall not
30 apply to a statewide elected official who is an ex officio member of
31 a board or commission.

1 D. Any person who willfully violates any provision of this
2 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof
3 shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
4 nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment
5 for not longer than six (6) months or by both such fine and
6 imprisonment, and upon conviction shall be ineligible for
7 appointment to or employment in a position in state service and, if
8 at the time of conviction is an employee of the state, shall forfeit
9 his or her position.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
