11 An Act relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting  
12 registration of certain conveyances as motor  
13 vehicles; authorizing operation of certain  
14 conveyances on city streets under certain  
15 circumstances; providing certain prohibition;  
16 providing for codification; and declaring an  
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1151.1 of Title 47, unless there  
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, golf carts or  
23 all terrain vehicles shall not be registered pursuant to the  
24 provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

25 B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, golf carts or  
26 all terrain vehicles shall not be operated on the highways or  
27 turnpikes of the state.

28 C. Golf carts or all terrain vehicles may be operated on city  
29 streets if:

30 1. The municipal governing body has adopted an ordinance  
31 governing the operation of golf carts or all terrain vehicles on  
32 city streets; and

2. Operation occurs during daylight hours only.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
