11 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

12 An Act relating to schools; authorizing teachers to
13 promote certain students to next grade under certain
14 conditions; stating design of summer academy
15 programs; making summer academy requirements
16 contingent upon the availability of funds; providing
17 for codification; providing effective date; and
18 declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.508E of Title 70, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A teacher who determines a third grade student is unable to meet
24 competencies required for completion of third grade and promotion to
25 fourth grade, shall have the authority to promote the student,
26 contingent upon the student's successful completion and mastery of
27 the required competencies at a summer academy. Summer academy
28 programs shall be designed to ensure the student masters
29 requirements necessary for promotion to fourth grade and shall
30 enhance next grade readiness. School districts shall only be
31 required to offer summer academies subject to the availability of
32 state funds for that purpose.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
