CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to general appropriations for the expenses of various agencies of the executive, legislative and judicial departments of the state; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Arts Council, the State Board of Education, the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the Oklahoma Department of Libraries, the Commissioners of the Land Office, the Physician Manpower Training Commission, the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools, the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics, the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology, the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation, the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education, the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System, the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector, the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund of the State Treasury, the Department of Central Services, the Department of Civil Emergency Management, the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, the State Election Board, the Ethics Commission, the Office of State Finance, the Office of the Governor, the Oklahoma House of Representatives, the Legislative Service Bureau, the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission, the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma, the Office of Personnel Management, the Office of the Secretary of State, the Oklahoma State Senate, the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the Department of Transportation, the Office of State Treasurer, the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth, the Office of Handicapped Concerns, the Oklahoma Human Rights Commission, the Oklahoma Department of Human Services, the Oklahoma Indian Affairs Commission, the Office of Juvenile Affairs, the Department of Mental Health And Substance Abuse Services, the State Department of Rehabilitation Services, the State Department of Health, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority, the University Hospitals Authority, the J.D. McCarty Center for Children with Developmental Disabilities, the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, the State Department of Agriculture, the State Banking Department, the Oklahoma Conservation Commission, the Department of Consumer Credit, the Corporation Commission, the Department of

Environmental Quality, the Oklahoma Historical Society, the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, the State Insurance Department, the J.M. Davis Memorial Commission, the Oklahoma Department of Labor, the Oklahoma Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board, the State Department of Mines, the Oklahoma Securities Commission, the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board, the Will Rogers Memorial Commission, the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission, the Office of the Attorney General, the Department of Corrections, the Court of Criminal Appeals, the State Fire Marshal, the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, the Council on Judicial Complaints, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations, the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, the Pardon and Parole Board, the Department of Public Safety, the Supreme Court, the Workers' Compensation Court and the Oklahoma State Employees Deferred Savings Incentive Plan Fund; stating sums of the appropriations; stating purposes and restrictions; authorizing and requiring certain expenditures; directing the transfer of certain funds to the Oklahoma Historical Society for preparatory work for a new history center; transferring certain funds to the Native American Cultural and Educational Authority Fund; making certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing effective dates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SUBCOMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Arts Council from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$3,885,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Billion One Hundred Fifty-five Million Three Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Ninety-six Dollars

(\$1,155,357,096.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Education Reform Revolving Fund created in Section 41.29b of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-two Million Eight Hundred Twenty-seven Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars (\$372,827,737.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 4. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Mineral Leasing Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the financial support of public schools.

SECTION 5. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Four Million Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand Eight Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$4,418,812.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the support of public school activities.

SECTION 6. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Hundred Forty-nine Million Eight Hundred Sixty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-eight Dollars (\$149,866,838.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the support of public school activities.

SECTION 7. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Nineteen Million One Hundred Ninety-six Thousand Four Hundred Forty-eight Dollars

(\$19,196,448.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase of textbooks.

SECTION 8. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Two Hundred Forty-one Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-six Dollars (\$241,876.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Accountability by law.

SECTION 9. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Nineteen Million Forty Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$19,040,465.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for Administrative and Support Functions of the State Department of Education.

SECTION 10. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million One Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-six Dollars (\$1,159,466.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Certified Employee Health Benefit Allowance.

SECTION 11. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Six Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Five Hundred Sixteen Dollars (\$675,516.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Support Personnel Health Benefit Allowance.

SECTION 12. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Three

Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$3,315,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law.

SECTION 13. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Six Hundred Seventy-seven Million Two Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-nine Dollars (\$677,259,679.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 14. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Nine Million Four Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-two Dollars (\$9,475,532.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 15. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of Thirty-seven Million Eight Hundred Fifty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-two Dollars (\$37,853,842.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for

allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 16. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999, the sum of Four Million Three Hundred Sixty-nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-eight Dollars (\$4,369,968.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for allocation by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution for the education and general operating budgets of the institutions and for other programs, construction, renovations or repairs administered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 17. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Million Eight Hundred Forty-four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-two Dollars (\$4,844,262.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the general operating budget of the Administrative Offices of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

SECTION 18. A. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Twelve Million Dollars (\$12,000,000.00) which shall be subject to the restrictions in subsection B of this section.

B. None of the funds appropriated in subsection A of this section shall be expended except as authorized by law, which authorization shall specifically provide for the expenditure of said funds.

SECTION 19. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Six Million Three Hundred Thirty-four Thousand Dollars (\$6,334,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

SECTION 20. There is hereby appropriated to Commissioners of the Land Office from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Commissioners of the Land Office Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Four Hundred Six Thousand Dollars (\$3,406,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Commissioners of the Land Office by law.

SECTION 21. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Million Nine Hundred Eight Thousand Dollars (\$4,908,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law.

SECTION 22. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law.

SECTION 23. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Hundred Fifty-eight Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$158,790.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by law.

SECTION 24. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Million Five Hundred Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$4,516,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law.

SECTION 25. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Eleven Million Six Hundred Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$11,607,550.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology by law.

SECTION 26. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Dollars (\$1,554,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law.

SECTION 27. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education from any monies not otherwise

appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Hundred Eleven Million Three Hundred Sixteen Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$111,316,770.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Board of Vocational and Technical Education by law.

SECTION 28. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Hundred Thirty-five Million Eight Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Eight Hundred Three Dollars (\$135,828,803.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Teachers' Retirement System by law.

SUBCOMMITTEE ON GENERAL GOVERNMENT AND TRANSPORTATION

SECTION 29. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Million Nine Hundred Seventy-eight Thousand Four Hundred Nine Dollars (\$4,978,409.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

SECTION 30. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Hundred Ninety-nine Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-one Dollars (\$499,591.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Commission on County Government Personnel Education and Training. The appropriation made in this section shall be expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 31. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide uniform computer systems development, including computer software for county government, in accordance with the State Auditor and Inspector's duties to prescribe accounting procedures and to provide technical assistance to county government. The appropriation made in this section shall be expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 32. There is hereby appropriated to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund of the State Treasury from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Fifteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$15,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the provisions of Section 2006 through 2013 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 33. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Seven Million Six Hundred Sixty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$7,662,873.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Central Services by law.

SECTION 34. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand One Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$3,830,117.00) to be transferred to the Building and Facility Revolving Fund created in Section 63.1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the purpose of

maintaining state buildings operated by the Department of Central Services.

SECTION 35. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$4,875.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform maintenance on the Veterans Memorial within the capitol complex.

SECTION 36. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Public Building Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Million Two Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-five Dollars (\$1,232,435.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for asbestos abatement programs and for the expenses of filing claims for reimbursement from the Manville Property Damage Settlement Trust. The monies designated in this section shall be expended exclusively for the purposes so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 37. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Hundred Ninety-two Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$192,700.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to maintain the Hissom Memorial Center.

SECTION 38. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Thirteen Million Two Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Dollars (\$13,264,000.00) for transfer to the Capital Improvement Revolving Fund.

SECTION 39. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Civil Emergency Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Five Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Eight Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$588,817.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Civil Emergency Management by law.

SECTION 40. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Civil Emergency Management from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform duties imposed upon the Department of Civil Emergency Management by law.

SECTION 41. There is hereby appropriated to Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Nineteen Million Two Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$19,275,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law. Of the said appropriation, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Commerce Revolving Fund.

SECTION 42. There is hereby appropriated to Oklahoma Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law.

SECTION 43. From monies available in the Capital Improvement Revolving Fund, the Department of Central Services is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to the Native American Cultural

and Educational Authority Fund the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00).

SECTION 44. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Five Million Ninety-eight Thousand Dollars (\$5,098,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Election Board by law.

SECTION 45. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$1,260,000.00) or so much thereof as may be required to pay the necessary expenses of holding elections.

SECTION 46. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000.00) or so much thereof as may be required to pay the necessary expenses of holding the Presidential Preferential Primary.

SECTION 47. There is hereby appropriated to the Ethics Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$420,350.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Ethics Commission by law.

SECTION 48. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of State Finance from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Eight Million Six Hundred Thirty-six Thousand

Dollars (\$8,636,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of State Finance by law.

SECTION 49. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Governor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the following amount or so much thereof as may be required for the following purposes:

SECTION 50. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Seventeen Million Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$17,025,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay the salaries, per diem and expenses of the members of the House of Representatives, the salaries of the employees of the House of Representatives, and other necessary expenses. Claims and payrolls filed against the appropriation made to the House of

Representatives for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, shall be approved by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 51. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma House of Representatives from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$550,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase of Oklahoma Statutes, Session Laws, and Supplements.

SECTION 52. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Twenty-seven Million Eight Thousand Three Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$27,008,361.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform

the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department by law.

SECTION 116. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Seven Hundred Thirty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$3,736,815.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law.

SECTION 117. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$4,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the provisions of Section 2003 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 118. There is hereby appropriated to the Will Rogers Memorial Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Six Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-nine Dollars (\$675,959.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Will Rogers Memorial Commission by law.

SECTION 119. There is hereby appropriated to the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Seven Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Dollars (\$3,724,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission by law.

SECTION 120. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Five Million Nine Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$5,948,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

SECTION 121. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General for deposit in the Attorney General's Evidence Fund provided for in Section 19 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for expenses related to official responsibilities of the Attorney General.

SECTION 122. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for legal representation of the Public Employees Relations Board. The monies designated in this section shall be used exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be transferable.

SECTION 123. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Twenty-eight Million Three Hundred Forty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Forty Dollars (\$28,345,740.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the district attorneys and the District Attorneys Council by law.

SECTION 124. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the

Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) or so much thereof as may be required by the district attorneys and District Attorneys Council to pay witness fees as required by Section 82 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 125. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Hundred Five Thousand Dollars (\$305,000.00) or so much thereof as may be required by the district attorneys and District Attorneys Council to pay witness fees as required by Section 82 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 126. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to be transferred to the District Attorneys Evidence Fund.

SECTION 127. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Hundred Twenty-seven Million Fifty Thousand Nine Hundred Ten Dollars (\$327,050,910.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law.

SECTION 128. There is hereby appropriated to the Court of Criminal Appeals from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Two Million Four Hundred Fifty-three Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$2,453,914.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law.

SECTION 129. There is hereby appropriated to the State Fire Marshal from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Million Six Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-seven Dollars (\$1,614,797.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State Fire Marshal by law.

SECTION 130. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Thirteen Million Six Hundred Eleven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$13,611,570.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law.

SECTION 131. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,300,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law.

SECTION 132. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Nine Million Four Hundred Sixty-four Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$9,464,850.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law.

SECTION 133. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Judicial Complaints from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Two Hundred Ninety-two Thousand Dollars (\$292,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to

perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law.

SECTION 134. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise appropriated from C.L.E.E.T. Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Two Million One Hundred Thirty Thousand One Hundred Eight Dollars (\$2,130,108.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law.

SECTION 135. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the C.L.E.E.T. Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1998, the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Ninety-five Dollars (\$260,095.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law.

SECTION 136. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$354,277.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law.

SECTION 137. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Thirty Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-one Dollars (\$3,030,971.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law.

SECTION 138. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not

otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Four Million Eight Hundred Ninety-four Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-four Dollars (\$4,894,724.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law.

SECTION 139. There is hereby appropriated to the Pardon and Parole Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of One Million Eight Hundred Two Thousand Dollars (\$1,802,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Pardon and Parole Board by law.

SECTION 140. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Fifty-nine Million Three Hundred Six Thousand Ninety-nine Dollars (\$59,306,099.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

SECTION 141. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purchase of motor vehicles.

SECTION 142. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Sixteen Million Two Hundred Eighty-nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-two Dollars (\$16,289,982.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the District Courts by law.

SECTION 143. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the State Judicial Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Seventeen Million Three Hundred Eighty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars (\$17,388,928.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the District Courts by law.

SECTION 144. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Five Hundred Fifty-two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$552,630.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the District Courts by law.

SECTION 145. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Twelve Million Six Hundred Twenty-one Thousand Thirty-nine Dollars (\$12,621,039.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Supreme Court or Court of Civil Appeals by law.

SECTION 146. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court for deposit in the Supreme Court Revolving Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000.00) for expenditures authorized by Section 1310.1 of Title 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 147. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Four Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Five Hundred Five Dollars (\$482,505.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Supreme Court or Court of Civil Appeals by law.

SECTION 148. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) to transfer to the Legal Services Revolving Fund created pursuant to subsection G of Section 921.1 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 149. There is hereby appropriated to the Workers' Compensation Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Six Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand One Hundred One Dollars (\$3,659,101.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law.

SECTION 150. There is hereby appropriated to the Workers' Compensation Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law.

SECTION 151. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Employees Deferred Savings Incentive Plan Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of Three Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,900,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide contributions to qualified participants pursuant to Section 1707 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 152. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State Employees Deferred Savings Incentive Plan Fund from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,900,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to provide

contributions to qualified participants pursuant to Section 1707 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 153. Appropriations made in Sections 10, 11, 16, 40, 42, 57, 84, 93, 94, 97, 101, 103 and 131 of this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999 (hereafter FY-99) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000 (hereafter FY-00). Funds budgeted for FY-99 may be encumbered only through June 30, 1999, and must be expended by November 15, 1999. Any funds remaining after November 15, 1999, and not budgeted for FY-00, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-00 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2000. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2000, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-99, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-00, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budgeted work program revision removing these funds from the FY-99 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 154. Appropriations made in Sections 1 through 9, 12 through 15, 17 through 39, 41, 44 through 56, 58 through 83, 85 through 92, 95, 96, 98 through 100, 102, 105 through 130, and 132 through 152 of this act, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000 (hereafter FY-00) or may be budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001 (hereafter FY-01). Funds budgeted for FY-00 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2000, and must be expended by November 15, 2000. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2000, and not budgeted for FY-01, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted

for FY-01 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2001. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2001, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-00, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-01, after the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared and submitted a budgeted work program revision removing these funds from the FY-00 budget work program and after such revision has been approved by the Office of State Finance.

SECTION 155. Sections 10, 11, 16, 40, 42, 43, 57, 84, 93, 94, 97, 101, 103, 104, 131 and 153 of this act shall become effective April 8, 1999.

SECTION 156. Sections 1, 5 through 9, 12 through 15, 17 through 39, 41, 44 through 56, 58 through 83, 85 through 92, 95, 96, 98 through 100, 102, 105 through 130, 132 through 152 and 154 of this act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 157. Sections 2 through 4 of this act shall become effective August 1, 1999.

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
