CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; providing for a course of treatment; requiring approval of drugs used in treatment; requiring certain tests; amending 74 O.S. 1991, Section 30d, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 227, O.S.L. 1997 (74 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 30d); which relates to the Oklahoma Drug and Alcohol Abuse Policy Board; changing board termination date; repealing 43A O.S. 1991, as amended by Section 53, Chapter 354, O.S.L. 1996 (43A O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 3-602), which relates to case review teams; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-604 of Title 43A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A course of treatment may include but shall not be limited to short-term detoxification, interim maintenance treatment or comprehensive maintenance treatment depending on the availability of such services and the needs of the individual.

B. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall approve any drug to be used in a narcotic treatment program and set guidelines for the maximum daily dose, not to exceed limits set by Title 21 of the Code of Federal Regulations. Pregnancy tests

for women shall be conducted upon admission and at least annually thereafter, unless otherwise indicated.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 1991, Section 30d, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 227, O.S.L. 1997 (74 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 30d), is amended to read as follows:

Section 30d. Termination of Board.

The Oklahoma Drug and Alcohol Abuse Policy Board shall cease to exist after July 1, ~~2000~~ 2001.

SECTION 3. REPEALER 43A O.S. 1991, Section 3-602, as amended by Section 53, Chapter 354, O.S.L. 1996 (43A O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 3-602), is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
