CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools; providing for the budgeting of funds in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees of the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools; limiting the salary of the Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures for each budget category.

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Thirty-eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-one Dollars (\$38,281.00) per annum, payable monthly for the months of July, August and

September 2000. Effective October 1, 2000, the salary of the Director shall not exceed Forty Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-one Dollars (\$40,281.00) per annum, payable monthly for the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001. The Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
