CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Constitutional Reserve Fund; making an appropriation to the Department of Transportation; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the State Emergency Fund; stating purpose; making an appropriation to the Water Resources Board; stating purpose; making appropriations nonfiscal; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Transportation from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Seventy Million Six Hundred Forty-three Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$70,643,612.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund the purposes set forth in Section 2002 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The appropriation set forth in this section shall be transferred to the State Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Emergency Fund created pursuant to Section 139.42 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for state emergencies.

SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Water Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Constitutional Reserve Fund of the State Treasury the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for weather modification.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
