COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Militia; amending 44 O.S. 1991, Section 74, which relates to officers and enlisted men and women; providing condition for reimbursement; deleting language; modifying allowances; repealing 44 O.S. 1991, Section 46, which relates to equipment reimbursement; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 1991, Section 74, is amended to read as follows:

Section 74. Officers and enlisted men and women while in active service of the state shall receive the same pay ~~and allowances~~ as paid for the same rank or grade for service in the Army or Air Force of the United States. Officers and enlisted men and women while in active service of the state shall receive the same allowances as paid for the same rank or grade of service in the Army or Air Force of the United States, unless the State of Oklahoma provides lodging quarters and meals for those personnel.

SECTION 2. REPEALER 44 O.S. 1991, Section 46, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
