BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-702c of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health may apply to the Secretary for  
the federal Department of Health and Human Services for any and all  
waivers, grants, or other assistance that would allow or facilitate  
the establishment of a program of enhanced reimbursement for  
services provided to Medicare beneficiaries in emergency hospitals.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5024 of Title 63, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority may establish a reimbursement  
methodology that will enhance the reimbursement for services  
provided to Medicaid beneficiaries in emergency hospitals.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
