BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7307-1.9 of Title 10, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Office of Juvenile Affairs shall, in cooperation with
sheriffs in this state, develop procedures for providing timely and
relevant information to sheriffs concerning juvenile court records
and agency records of persons who have met the criteria specified in
paragraph 5 of subsection C of Section 7307-1.2 of Title 10 of the
Oklahoma Statutes. The procedures shall be designed to provide the
type of information useful and relevant to establishing security
level requirements for persons in the custody of a sheriff. The
provisions of this section shall not require the disclosure of any
records or information which is required by law to be kept
confidential.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
