BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 625.2 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Statewide Independent Living Council which shall be established pursuant to the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Public Law 93-112, codified at 29 U.S.C., Section 701 et seq., as amended.

B. The duties of the Council shall be those as set forth in the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

C. Subject to the availability of state funds other than those appropriated to the Department of Rehabilitation Services, in accordance with the State Plan for Independent Living, the Department of Rehabilitation Services, in joint effort with the Statewide Independent Living Council, may contract with independent living centers for the purpose of providing independent living services to individuals with disabilities and their families.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
