An Act relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting inattentive driving; providing method of enforcement; establishing penalty; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-901.1 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Every person who operates a motor vehicle on any street, highway or parking lot, publicly maintained and open for public access, shall devote the attention necessary for the safe operation of the vehicle so as not to endanger the safety of persons or property. A violation of this section may only be enforced by a law enforcement officer after conducting an investigation involving a motor vehicle collision and the person is not cited for any other violation which the officer determined was the primary cause of the collision.

B. Every person convicted of a violation of this section shall be guilty of inattentive driving and shall be punished by a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 1999.
