BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the  
Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall budget all funds in the  
following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law shall be set  
by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed  
\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal  
year ending June 30, 2000. The Oklahoma State Bureau of  
Investigation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, shall be  
subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures for  
capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant

to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. Of the amount appropriated to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, a maximum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) may be transferred to an agency special account for the purpose of purchasing evidence items, paying fees to informers or special employees, paying expenses incurred in the prosecution and defense of civil actions, and paying other expenses as incurred under the Evidence Fund activity in trying to apprehend and convict violators of the laws of the state. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall report income to the Evidence Fund annually pursuant to the provisions of Sections 41.7c and 41.29 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 4. Of the \_\_\_\_\_ (0) full-time-equivalent employee positions authorized for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation in this act, eleven (11.0) shall perform duties in accordance with the Criminal Intelligence Unit, nine (9.0) shall perform duties in accordance with the Criminal Records Audit Unit, and five (5.0) shall perform duties in accordance with the Marijuana Analysis Project. The continuation of these full-time-equivalent employees is contingent upon sufficient agency revolving funds and federal funding to support them.

SECTION 5. This act shall become effective September 1, 1999.
