BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the Board of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by the Chief Medical Examiner. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000. The Board of Medicolegal Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as

may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
