BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3218.15 of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is the intent of the Legislature that by the fall of the
2001-2002 school year, all remedial courses in the comprehensive
universities shall be terminated. Technical branches of
comprehensive universities will retain remedial classes as course
offerings.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.
