

An Act relating to schools; requiring athletic items to be separate in the annual school audit; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 22-103.1 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The board of education of each school district shall provide for and cause to be made as part of the annual audit of such school district for each fiscal year a separate item by site containing all costs related to that district's and sites athletic programs. Such separate item costs shall include expenditures from the general fund and building fund, and shall include but not be limited to:

1. Salaries of coaches, assistants and athletic directors;
2. Athletic facilities;
3. Athletic equipment and supplies; and
4. Athletic uniforms.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
