BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of The State Auditor and Inspector from monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) to be allocated to the substate planning districts as specified by law, or so much thereof as may be necessary for accomplishing the provisions of the Local and Regional Capital Improvement Planning Process Act. Of said amount:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be distributed through contract with regional councils, as specified by Section 911 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Contracts shall require eligible regional councils to assist units of local government in their statutory responsibilities in establishing or revising local capital improvement plans. Distribution of funds shall be based on a formula whereby each regional council shall receive an equal share; and

2. \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be distributed through contract to the Oklahoma Association of Regional Councils, Inc., for

the purpose of providing training, assessment and coordination services to capital improvement planning programs.

SECTION 2. The appropriations in this act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
