BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

DEPARTMENT OF CENTRAL SERVICES

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Central Services from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Central Services by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, the Department of Central Services shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

The duties and compensation of employees, not otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Central Services by law shall be set by the Director of the Department of Central Services. The salary of the Director shall not exceed Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001. The Department of Central Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
