An Act relating to schools; providing for an opportunity for an individual advisement session for certain students; listing participants in the session; stating purpose of the session; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-103.2e of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Prior to enrollment in the ninth grade, every student enrolled in a public school in this state shall be provided an opportunity for an individual advisement session. The student, the parents or guardians of the student, and a school staff member shall be involved in the individual advisement session. The purpose of the session shall be to develop a plan of high school courses the student should take and to develop strategies for achieving the postsecondary goals of the student.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2000.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
