An Act relating to counties and county officers;
authorizing county officers and employees to receive
travel reimbursement and per diem in lieu of travel
allowances; providing for codification; and providing
an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 169 of Title 19, unless there is
created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

In lieu of travel and expense reimbursement and travel
allowances allowed by law for county officers and employees, county
officers and employees may be allowed travel reimbursement and per
diem pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
