A Concurrent Resolution congratulating Mr. Steve Shiever on being named Oklahoma's public school Administrator of the Year; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the key to the future of Oklahoma lies in the hearts and minds of two of our state's greatest resources, its educators and its students; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Steve Shiever, who is superintendent of the Frontier school district, will be recognized as an outstanding example of excellence as an administrator in the public school system of Oklahoma at the annual Academic Awards Banquet in Oklahoma City on May 15, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Steve Shiever began his teaching career in 1970, his administrative duties as a high school principal in 1971, and then became a superintendent in 1974; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Steve Shiever moved to the Red Rock school district in 1989 when two Noble County school districts, Marland and Red Rock, were consolidated to form the Frontier school district; and

WHEREAS, major restructuring of the new Frontier school district was enacted by Mr. Steve Shiever as he individualized instruction and integrated a distributive computer network; and

WHEREAS, the Frontier school district, under the leadership of Mr. Steve Shiever, is recognized as one of the most technologically advanced school districts in the nation with a fully integrated system of televisions, telephones and teacher stations in each classroom, all linked to servers and a media retrieval system, which

provides curriculum enhancement through video, laser and compact discs, cable, and the Internet; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Steve Shiever has also found time to provide service to many state education organizations, including the Oklahoma Association of School Administrators, the Oklahoma Association of School Business Officials, the Oklahoma Association Serving Impacted Schools, the Oklahoma Distance Learning Association, the Organization of Rural Oklahoma Schools, the Superintendents Advisory Council and the Oklahoma Technology Administrators Association; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Steve Shiever has been selected as Oklahoma's public school Administrator of the Year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature congratulates and supports Mr. Steve Shiever on the outstanding job he has done and on being selected Oklahoma's public school Administrator of the Year.

THAT the Oklahoma Legislature encourages other Oklahoma education administrators to follow the example and lead of Mr. Steve Shiever in the inclusion of technology in the classroom for the betterment of public school education.
