A Concurrent Resolution relating to rules of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board; waiving the thirty-legislative-day review period for proposed permanent rule OAC 785:30-3-5.1 and proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 785:45-1-2 and OAC 785:46-1-2, relating to taking and use of groundwater, Oklahoma's Water Quality Standards and implementation of Oklahoma's Water Quality Standards; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 308 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Legislature may waive the thirty-legislative-day review period for any rule which has been transmitted for legislative review; and

WHEREAS, on April 15, 1999, the Oklahoma Water Resources Board submitted to the Legislature for its review, proposed amendments to proposed permanent rule OAC 785:30-3-5.1 and proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 785:45-1-2 and OAC 785:46-1-2, relating to taking and use of groundwater, Oklahoma's Water Quality Standards and implementation of Oklahoma's Water Quality Standards, regarding permit application requirements and general provisions; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the substantive value and importance of such proposed permanent rule and proposed amendments to permanent rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the Legislature hereby waives the thirty-legislative-day review period of proposed permanent rule OAC 785:30-3-5.1 and proposed amendments to permanent rules OAC 785:45-1-2 and OAC 785:46-1-2.

THAT copies of this resolution shall be distributed to the Governor, the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board and the Editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
