A Concurrent Resolution declaring May 13, 2000,  
as Project HomeSafe Day in the State of  
Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Lieutenant Governor Mary Fallin along with the National Shooting Sports Foundation, Braum's Ice Cream and Dairy Store, the National Rifleman's Association, the Oklahoma Rifleman's Association, the Oklahoma Sheriff's Association and the Oklahoma Safe Kids Coalition have brought Project HomeSafe to the State of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, Project HomeSafe is a voluntary program to promote safe firearms handling and storage practices among firearm owners; and

WHEREAS, Project HomeSafe will provide free and voluntary gun-locking devices to the citizens of Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, several local and state law enforcement agencies will assist in the distribution of the gun-locking devices of the Lieutenant Governor's Project HomeSafe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 47TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT May 13, 2000, shall be declared as "Project HomeSafe Day" in the State of Oklahoma.

THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to the coordinators of Project HomeSafe, Braum's Ice Cream and Dairy Store, the National Rifleman's Association, the Oklahoma Rifleman's

Association, the Oklahoma Sheriff's Association and the Oklahoma Safe Kids Coalition.
