BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 45 O.S. 1991, Section 1d, as amended by Section 12, Chapter 364, O.S.L. 1998 (45 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1d), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1d. A. The Director of the Department of Mines with the approval of the Oklahoma Mining Commission ~~shall have and is hereby~~ authorized to exercise the following duties:

1. To appoint a ~~miner certification advisory council~~ Miner Certification Advisory Council or other such advisory council as may be required ~~to accomplish government functions;~~ and
2. To provide assistance, advice and counsel to the Commission when requested.

B. ~~Any advisory~~ Advisory councils shall meet at such times and places as the members may deem most convenient for the transaction of business. ~~A~~ The presence of a majority of the membership of such councils ~~an advisory council~~ shall constitute a quorum. ~~Each member of such councils shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in the discharge of official duties with approval of the Director and the Commission as provided in the State Travel Reimbursement Act~~ Members of advisory councils shall be reimbursed for travel expenses by the Department as provided by the State

Travel Reimbursement Act with approval of the Director and the Commission.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
