

ENGROSSED SENATE
BILL NO. 1119

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; amending Section 1, Chapter 249, O.S.L. 1998 (69 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1286), which relates to highway beautification; clarifying statutory reference; requiring Legislative approval for the adoption of certain rules; prohibiting alteration or modification of certain rule or definition; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 249, O.S.L. 1998 (69 O.S. Supp. 1999, Section 1286), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1286. For the purpose of highway beautification, the Transportation Commission may adopt rules regarding the repair or maintenance of, or changes to, nonconforming advertising signs, displays or devices, as defined in Section 1278 of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, including the size, height, lighting, replacement, rebuilding, or re-erection of such structures. Provided however, any such rule shall not alter, delete, modify or otherwise amend the definition or meaning of any term set forth in Section 1273 et seq. of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2000.
