BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

OKLAHOMA CENTER FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, the  
Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology shall  
budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and  
Technology by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Center for the  
Advancement of Science and Technology. The salary of the Director  
shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable  
monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000. The Oklahoma

Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2000, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 1999.
