BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1725 of Title 2, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is unlawful for any person to transport anhydrous ammonia in any amount in an unapproved container. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term not exceeding two (2) years, or by a fine of not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment. For purposes of this section, "unapproved container" means any container not serving a legitimate agricultural purpose.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
